Entry Fee: \$10 per piece (members)
\$15 per piece (non-members)

Open to Art Quilts, both 2D & 3D. Only entries that have not been in a previous juried show at the NHAC may be submitted. Entries require tags on back with name and title. They do not need to be covered, as quilts will be judged once they are hung. A 4" sleeve on the back is required for hanging. *If special hanging circumstances are required, please contact the office prior to entry.* All personal armatures must be labeled with name. There is no theme for this show. Quilt artist will be notified to pick up any unaccepted entries.

The show will be judged for awards, but quilts will not be juried into the show. Entries will be hung as long as space permits. The number of entries is not limited, however, there is an entry fee *per* piece. Registration forms available online & at the Art Center. Registration forms must be brought to the Art Center with entries at delivery. You may pre-register by email or phone.

The NHAC is not responsible for damages, loss or theft to any piece during, or if left after the show. Entries not picked up after 30 days following show closing becomes the property of the NHAC. The NHAC will take a 30% commission on any exhibited piece that is sold.

No piece of artwork shall be substituted or removed until the last day of the show.
