

Materials List- Palette Knife Workshop with Kim McAninch

Any brand of **oil-soluble and/or oil paints** are acceptable for this technique.

1- **4" x 6" canvas panel** on which we will work on a brief exercise.

The prepared substrate on which to paint that I recommend for this class is **11" x 14" stretched canvas/linen**.

Various **palette knives** for experimentation. I encourage people to find their own favorite while developing their own unique style. Below is what I use.

I predominantly use 25T and 30T because most importantly, they have a fine point and are thin and flexible for mixing and defined application. The tip can be used for fine work and drawing.

Another nice addition is a 44T.

A **mixing surface**- I use paper plates that have a light coating that resists drying out the paint, not styrofoam

Paper towels/paper napkins for wiping off the knives.
